1. William Spalding WILLIAMS. William was born at Bethnal Green, London, England, circa 1808. He was married as a subsequent marriage listed him as a widower, but no details are known about his wife. He married Elizabeth Crouch, daughter of Edmund Crouch, at Parish Church at Basingstoke, Hampshire, England, on 3 Aug 1839. William died between 1871 and 1881.

William was listed as the head of household at 12 Fortess Grove, St Pancras, Middlesex, England, in the 1861 census. He was recorded as William Williams, married, aged 53, a Cartman, and born London, Middlesex. Also recorded in the household with him were his wife Elizabeth, daughter Mary, and sons John and Charles.

William was listed as the head of household at 18 Satchwell Street, Bethnal Green, London, England, in the 1871 census. He was recorded as William Williams, married, aged 63, a Cab Driver, and born Bethnal Green, Middlesex. Also recorded in the household with him was his wife Elizabeth. There was no issue of William Spalding Williams and the unknown spouse mentioned above.

2. Alfred Edmund Spalding WILLIAMS was born at Paddington, London, England, circa 1842. He married Annie Humm on 30 Sep 1865 at Christ Church, Byculla, Bombay, Bombay, India. Alfred died on 25 Oct 1885 at Victoria, Australia.

Alfred Williams was listed as the Publican for the Newbridge Hotel in Victoria Street Richmond from 1880 to 1886. When he died in 1885 his widow continued as the Publican as Mrs Alfred Williams in 1887 and after she remarried as Mrs Annie Cook in 1888. Annie must have moved on in 1889 as a H.G. Willimott is listed as the Publican from that year.

Mary was listed as William Spalding Williams's daughter at 12 Fortess Grove, St Pancras, Middlesex, England, in the 1861 census. She was recorded as Mary Ann Williams, unmarried, aged 17, and born Reddale, Northumberland.

Mary was listed as the wife of James Dodd at 52 Fonthill Road, Islington, London, England, in the 1881 census. She was recorded as Mary A Dodd, married, aged 36, and born Northumberland.

Mary was listed as the head of household at 40 Fonthill Road, Islington, London, England, in the 1891 census. She was recorded as M A Dodd, widow, aged 46, a Dress mantle maker, and born Scotland (should have been Northumberland). Also recorded in the household with her were her mother Elizabeth Williams and a visitor Alice Atkins.

Mary was listed as the wife of Thomas Barrett Newell at the Green Man, 2 Romeland Hill, St Albans, Hertfordshire, England, in the 1901 census. She was recorded as Mary, married, aged 56, and born Kentish Town, London.

Children of Mary Ann Eliza Spalding Williams and James Dodd were as follows:

- i. JAMES was born at Clerkenwell, Middlesex, England, circa 1869. James died.  
James was listed as James Dodd's son at 52 Fonthill Road, Islington, London, England, in the 1881 census. He was recorded as James Dodd, aged 12, and born Clerkenwell, Middlesex.
- ii. WILLIAM was born circa 1871 at Islington, Middlesex, England.  
William was listed as James Dodd's son at 52 Fonthill Road, Islington, London, England, in the 1881 census. He was recorded as William Dodd, aged 10, and born Islington, Middlesex.
- iii. ATTLIA was born circa 1874 at Islington, Middlesex, England.  
Attlia was listed as James Dodd's daughter at 52 Fonthill Road, Islington, London, England, in the 1881 census.

7. iv. She was recorded as Attilia Dodd, aged 7, and born Islington, Middlesex.  
 LAURETTA VIOLET was born at Islington London, Middlesex, England, on 14 Jul 1879. She married Arthur William Southern, son of Arthur Mason Southern and Fanny Ruth Pendleton, at Watford, Hertfordshire, England, Mar Qtr 1906.

There was no issue of Mary Ann Eliza Spalding Williams and Thomas Barrett Newell.

4. John Archibald WILLIAMS was born at London, England, circa 1848. He married Annie Jane Dillon, daughter of John Dillon and Annie Jane Unknown, at Kotri, Sindh, Bombay Presidency, India, on 25 Aug 1879. John died on 15 Jun 1926 at Allansford, Victoria, Australia. His body was interred on 17 Jun 1926, at the at Warrnambool Cemetery at Victoria, Australia.

John was listed as William Spalding Williams's son at 12 Fortress Grove, St Pancras, Middlesex, England, in the 1861 census. He was recorded as John Williams, unmarried, aged 13, a Scholar, and born London, Middlesex. John's occupation: Engineer.

John Archibald Williams immigrated from London to Fremantle, Western Australia, on the Ortona arriving on the 4 Apr 1901. He was accompanied by his wife Annie Jane, his sons John Archibald, Alfred Spalding, Charles Cecil, Sidney Owen and daughters Ethel Clara and Annie Ruth. A report of the voyage published in the local newspaper for the R.M.S Ortona stated "The orient liner Ortona from London made her appearance up to time yesterday morning and berthed at the South Quay by 8-30 a.m. She came in flying the yellow flag and was boarded by the health officer Dr Hope before she reached the quay there being two cases of chicken pox on board. Pratique was granted shortly after she was made fast at the quay. The Ortona left London on March 1 and a strong S.W. gale with high seas were met to Plymouth which was left on the following day. To Gibraltar a westerly gale and heavy swell were experienced. That port was reached on the 6th and departure taken the same day for Marseilles which was left on the 8th in fine weather. Naples was left on the 11th after 1038 bags of mails were shipped. Squally weather prevailed to Port Said the steamer arriving there on the 14th and at Suez on the 15th and left again the same day reaching Colombo on the 25th after a fine weather passage from Aden. Departure was taken on the 26th for Fremantle during which run the weather was heavy with strong S.E. trades. The Ortona disembarked 88 passengers for the Port and landed 200 tons of cargo, having 300 passengers in transit which was increased by many from this State. The steamer bunkered 200 tons of coal and continued her voyage shortly after 3 p.m. The officers associated with Commander Hay on the present trip are :- T. Daniel (chief) A.J. Croft (second) C. Hersel (third) G.R. Bull (fourth) A. Hodsell (purser) C.F. Gibb (assistant purser) Dr. C. Bailon (surgeon) and R. Turnbull (chief engineer)."

 David Williams immigrated from London to Fremantle, Western Australia, on the Ortona arriving on the 4 Apr 1901. He was accompanied by his parents and family.
- x. BENJAMIN was born at India in 1896. Benjamin died in 1898 at India.
- xi. PRISCILLA ROSE was born at Saharanpur, Bengal, India, on 27 Dec 1897. She was baptised at Saharanpur, Bengal, India, on 6 Apr 1898. She married Clifford Haines. Priscilla died in 1959 at Parkville, Victoria, Australia.  
 Priscilla Rose Williams immigrated from London to Fremantle, Western Australia, on the Ortona arriving on the 4 Apr 1901. She was accompanied by her parents and family.

His body was cremated on 8 Sep 1966, at The Necropolis at Springvale, Victoria, Australia, and the ashes scattered.

Her common name was Violet.

Violet was listed as James Dodd's daughter at 52 Fonthill Road, Islington, London, England, in the 1881 census. She was recorded as Violet Dodd, aged 3, and born Islington, Middlesex.

Violet was listed as a Scholar at the Orphan Working School at St Pancras, Middlesex, England, in the 1891 census. She was recorded as Laretta Dodd, single, aged 11, a scholar, and born London.

Violet was listed as Thomas Barrett Newell's stepdaughter at the Green Man, 2 Romeland Hill, St Albans, Hertfordshire, England, in the 1901 census. She was recorded as Violet, single, aged 21, and born Islington, London.

Laretta Violet Dodd immigrated from England to United States of America. This was after Arthur was born in February 1907, living in St Paul Minnesota to some time after 1910 when she returned to England. The record of this immigration and her return to England has not yet been found.

Violet was listed as the wife of Arthur William Southern at St Paul, Minnesota, the United States of America, in the 1910 census. She was recorded as Laretta V Southern, married, aged 29, as none, and born in England where both her parents were also born. She was also listed as white, married for 4 years, with one child who was still living, immigrating in 1909, able to speak English and read and write.

Laretta Violet Dodd immigrated from Liverpool England to Ellis Island, New York, United States of America, on the S.S. Megantic arriving on the 10 Dec 1912. She was accompanied by her sons Arthur James and Frederic Pendleton.

Violet was listed as the wife of Arthur William Southern at 218 McDonald, Miami, Dade, Florida, United States of America, in the 1920 census. She was recorded as Loretta V Southern, married female, aged 40, as none, and born in England (mother tongue English) where both her parents were also born (their mother tongue being English). She was also listed as white, immigrating in 1908 and naturalised, able to speak English and read and write.

Violet was listed as the wife of Arthur William Southern at Election Precinct 9, Dade, Florida, United State of America, in the 1930 census. She was recorded as Laretta V Southern, married female, aged 50, as none, and born in England (mother tongue English) where both her parents were also born. She was also listed as white, immigrating in 1911 and naturalised, able to speak English, can read and write, aged 26 when she first married and had not attended school/college since 1 September 1929.

Children of Laretta Violet Dodd and Arthur William Southern were as follows:

- i. ARTHUR JAMES was born on 22 Feb 1907 at Watford, Hertfordshire, England. He married an unknown person circa 1930. He died on 17 Dec 1989 aged 82.

Arthur was listed as Arthur William Southern's son at St Paul, Minnesota, the United States of America, in the 1910 census. He was recorded as Arthur J Southern, single, aged 3, as none, and born in England where both his parents were also born. He was also listed as white.

Arthur James Southern immigrated from Liverpool England to Ellis Island, New York, United States of America, on the S.S. Megantic arriving on the 10 Dec 1912. mother and brother Frederic.

Arthur was listed as Arthur William Southern's son at 218 McDonald, Miami, Dade, Florida, United States of America, in the 1920 census. He was recorded as Arthur J Southern, single male, aged 12, as none, and born in England (mother tongue English) where both his parents were also born (their mother tongue being English). He was also listed as white, immigrating in 1908 and naturalised, attended school since 1 September 1919, able to speak English and read and write.

Arthur was listed as the head of household at Stapleton City, (Coast Guard Destroyer Tuppe), Richmond, New York, United States of America, in the 1930 census. He was recorded as Arthur J Southern, married male, aged 23, as a radio operator in the US Coast Guard, currently employed as a worker, and born in England where both his parents were also born. Also recorded in the household with him He was also listed as white, immigrating in 1913 and naturalised, able to speak English and read and write, and not a veteran of the US Military.
- ii. FREDERIC PENDLETON was born at Minnesota, United States of America, on 24 Sep 1910. He married an unknown person. Frederic died on 4 May 2003 at Florida, United States of America, aged 92.

Frederic Pendleton Southern immigrated from Liverpool England to Ellis Island, New York, United States of America, on the S.S. Megantic arriving on the 10 Dec 1912. mother and brother Arthur.

Frederic was listed as Arthur William Southern's son at 218 McDonald, Miami, Dade, Florida, United States of America, in the 1920 census. He was recorded as Frederic Southern, single male, aged 9, as none, and born in Minnesota (both his parents were born in England and their mother tongue being English). He was also listed as white and having attended school since 1 September 1919.

Frederic was listed as Arthur William Southern's son at Election Precinct 9, Dade, Florida, United State of America, in the 1930 census. He was recorded as Frederic P Southern, single male, aged 19, as an apprentice engraver in the newspaper industry, and born in Minnesota (both his parents were born in England). He was also listed as white, can speak English, an employed worker and has not attended school since 1 September 1929.
- iii. FLORENCE L was born at Florida, United States of America, circa 1914. Florence died.

Florence was listed as Arthur William Southern's daughter at 218 McDonald, Miami, Dade, Florida, United States of America, in the 1920 census. She was recorded as Florence L Southern, single female, aged 6, as none, and born in Florida (both her parents were born in England and their mother tongue being English). She was also listed as white.

Florence was listed as Arthur William Southern's daughter at Election Precinct 9, Dade, Florida, United State of America, in the 1930 census. She was recorded as Florence L Southern, single female, aged 16, as none, and born in Florida (both her parents were born in England). She was also listed as white, able to read and write, can speak English, and had not attended a school/college since 1 September 1929.
- iv. ETHEL I was born at Florida, United States of America, circa 1917. Ethel died.

Ethel was listed as Arthur William Southern's daughter at 218 McDonald, Miami, Dade, Florida, United States of America, in the 1920 census. She was recorded as Ethel I Southern, single female, aged 3 6/12, as none, and born in Florida (both her parents were born in England and their mother tongue being English). She was also listed as white.

Ethel was listed as Arthur William Southern's daughter at Election Precinct 9, Dade, Florida, United State of America, in the 1930 census. She was recorded as Ethel I Southern, single female, aged 13, as none, and born in Florida (both her parents were born in England). She was also listed as white, able to read and write, can speak English, and had not attended a school/college since 1 September 1929.

**8.** Ethel Clara WILLIAMS was born at India on 27 Oct 1883. She married Aenger Vincent Mathieson, son of Peter Mathieson and Mary MacMaster, at St Andrews Presbyterian Church at Kalgoorlie, Western Australia, Australia, on 4 Jul 1906. Ethel died on 2 Oct 1952 at Box Hill, Victoria, Australia, aged 68. Her body was interred on 6 Oct 1952, at the at Warrnambool Cemetery at Victoria, Australia.

Ethel Clara Williams immigrated from London to Fremantle, Western Australia, on the Ortona arriving on the 4 Apr 1901. She was accompanied by her parents and family.
